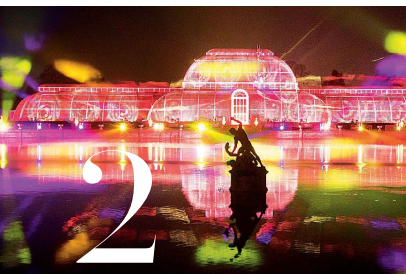




## Scents of ADVENTURE

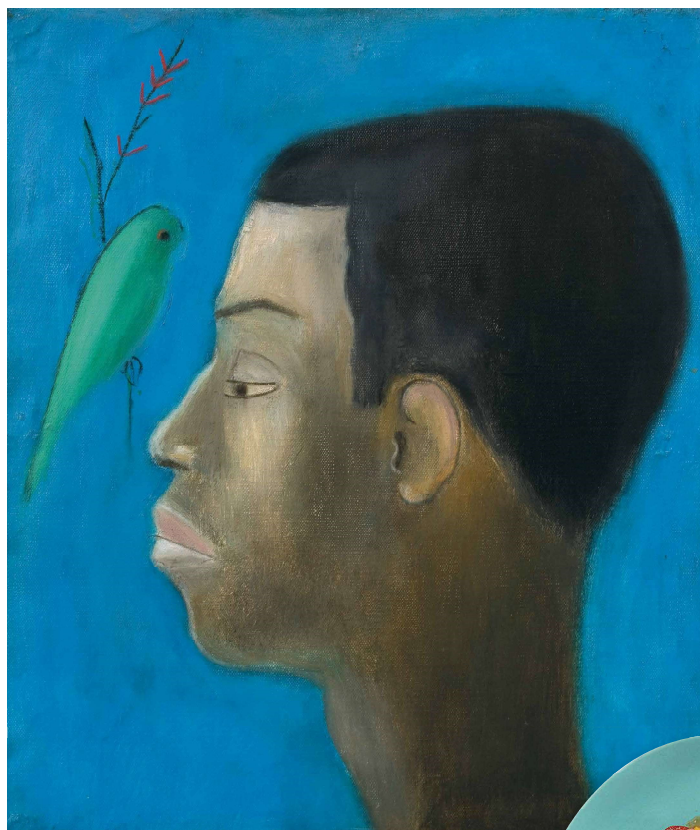


## RIGHT ON KEW
